We have put in place a range of measures at North Devon District Hospital to keep everyone safe from coronavirus.

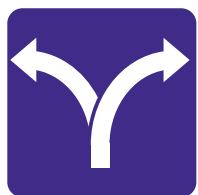


We are practising good hand hygiene

- ✓ Wash your hands well for 20 seconds using soap and water or hand sanitiser

We have separate areas to keep patients who might or do have COVID-19 apart from others



Our spaces are less crowded because we're doing more phone and video appointments instead of face-to-face appointments
